



**SAFEGUARDING EUROPEAN DEMOCRACY  
EUROSCOLA 2025 VIDEO COMPETITION  
TERMS & CONDITIONS**

**Entry rules**

1. The competition is open to all secondary schools in Ireland taking part in the European Parliament Ambassador School (EPAS) programme
2. Participants must be at least 14 years old.
3. Entries may be submitted in English or Irish
4. The project can be an individual or team entry.
5. Each school may submit one entry only.
6. Entries must be submitted by the teacher.
7. Each entry must be clearly linked to the theme of the competition.
8. Entries must be **maximum 1 minute long**.
9. Videos containing AI-generated content are not accepted and will be deemed inadmissible.

**When and how to submit your entry?**

10. Upload your video to YouTube
11. Make sure you have made your video Public on YouTube.
12. Complete the [Entry Form](#).
13. Deadline for entries: **17 October 2025**


**Evaluation**

14. Entries will be judged on message content, creativity and originality.
15. The judges' decision is final.

**The Prize**

16. We are awarding several educational visits to the European Parliament in Strasbourg to represent Ireland at [Euroscola](#) in 2026. Euroscola is a one-day youth parliament for 14-18 year olds, where students become an MEP for the day.

**The Winning Schools**

17. The group may consist of a minimum of 10 students with one accompanying teacher up to a maximum of 24 students and two accompanying teachers.
18. Winners will be notified via the email address provided in the application form.
19. The results of the competition will also be posted on our [website](#) and social media channels:

20. The exact dates of the trip to Strasbourg will be confirmed once the winners have been chosen.



### **Funding**

21. Payment is made by bank transfer in two instalments to the school bank account **after** the school's participation in Euroscola.
22. Each winning school will receive a financial subsidy per participant to cover travel costs based on the distance between the group's point of departure and Strasbourg.
23. Each school will also receive a fixed amount of funding per participant to cover accommodation and other minor costs.
24. Two overnight stays in Strasbourg are required.
25. Breakfast and lunch are provided on the Euroscola day in the European Parliament.
26. The winning schools are responsible for making their own travel and accommodation arrangements.
27. Group participants are strongly encouraged to hold personal travel and health insurance for the duration of their trip. The European Parliament does not provide personal insurance coverage.

### **Data protection and image rights**

28. The participants acknowledge and agree to provide the following information via the submission form:
  - school name and address
  - teacher name and email address
29. In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, participants are informed that their personal data may be processed by the European Parliament for institutional communication, as well as non-commercial promotional and educational purposes related to the Euroscola programme. This processing is carried out in line with Article 5(1)(a) of the Regulation and will be used solely for the purpose of the contest.
30. By submitting your entry you give consent to the European Parliament to use your video clip, copyright free, on its website, in its publications and on its social media platforms.
31. The names of the winning schools and their videos will be published on our social media channels, website, newsletters and will also be distributed to the regional press. Highly commended videos may also be published as above.
